SECTION VIII CONTROL MEASURES**

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION

Use NIOSH approved respirator under appropriate OSHA standards and regulations. A combination of both proper ventilation and respiratory protection would tend to eliminate most risks.

VENTILATION

Local exhause is recommended

PROTECTIVE GLOVES

Impermeable recommended.

EYE PROTECTION

Solvent resistant safety eyewear with splash guards or side shields is recommended. Contact lenses should not be worn

OTHER PROTECTIVE CLOTHING OR EQUIPMENT

Eye wash facility and safety shower recommended. Use impermeable aprons and protective clothing whenever possible to prevent skin contact.

WORK/HYGIENIC PRACTICES

Wash hands with soap and water after using and before eating or drinking.
