10. Preparation

Clean area of any dust, dirt, mildew, oil and other foreign substance. For existing applications remove all old caulking before applying new caulk, clean area with a mild solution of bleach and water.

11. Application

Make sure area is dry before applying caulk. Remove cap and cut spout to desired bead thickness. Apply Caulk when temperature is above 40°F. Tool Caulking within 10 minutes of application using a wet finger or damp rag. Excess may be cleaned up with a damp cloth before caulk begins to skin over.

12. Cure Time

Caulk is fully cured in 3-5 days depending on temperature, humidity and thickness of application.
